

**BOROUGH OF WOODBINE  
WORKSHOP MEETING**

**MARCH 2, 2018  
7:30 P.M.**

Mayor Pikolycky called the Workshop Meeting to order and read the following statement, "Adequate notice of this meeting was provided in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act by notifying the Press and The Herald on January 23, 2018 and posting a copy of said notice on the Clerk's bulletin board."

Those present were: Mayor Pikolycky; Councilpersons Ortiz, Johnson, Bennett, Benson and Cruz. Also present were: Richard Tonetta, Borough Solicitor; Bruce Graham Borough Engineer; and Lisa Garrison, Borough Clerk. Councilwoman Perez was absent due to illness.

Mayor Pikolycky called for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Unfinished Business –

Pedestrian & Bikeway Safety Improvements Status - Mr. Graham indicated the contract had been awarded to Charles Marandino and a preconstruction conference had been held. Construction is anticipated to begin early next week.

County Road Project Phase II 550/638 Update - Mr. Graham indicated we are waiting to receive the plans from the County for Route 638. He also indicated the County will be including a variable message sign as part of the Route 638 project.

Open Space Project - Mr. Graham indicated the construction is continuing with the clearing essentially complete. The excavation has begun. Mayor Pikolycky advised a ground breaking ceremony will be held on March 20<sup>th</sup> at 1:00 p.m. Mr. Zumpino reported on the financing of the next phases.

DEP Issues – Asset Management Plan Status - Mr. Graham indicated an itemization along with identifying costs needs to be completed and submitted.

Rabies Clinic – March 3, 2018 – 10:00 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Stockton Needs Assessment Proposal - Mr. Zumpino reviewed the proposal to conduct a community engagement needs assessment with Council.

610/550 Roundabout - Mr. Graham indicated the County awarded the project to Urban Engineers to begin the process.

Local Planning Services Grant - Mr. Graham indicated he has not heard anything further at this time and will reach out.

New Business –

Reconstruction Sumner Avenue – DOT Award \$175,000 - Mr. Graham indicated the total project would cost \$400,00 and would be completed in phases financing permitting.

Sprint - Mr. Graham indicated Sprint had submitted a zoning permit application and escrow had been posted. He further indicated this information had been sent to V-tech to review.

Mr. Zumpino reported on the following:

State Senate Bill 250- Mr. Zumpino reported the CMC Airport would be entitled to tax credits for jobs created. Senator Van Drew's office had been contacted to include the Borough's airport. Mr. Tonetta indicated the bill needs to be revised as it is indicated the Borough airport as an authority.

Fire Truck - Mr. Zumpino indicated proposals are being reviewed and an application is to be submitted to USDA for supplemental funds.

Head Start Project - Mr. Zumpino indicated a conference call had been held with the architects to settle certain issues and further discussion is needed.

There being no further business, on motion of Councilman Cruz, seconded by Councilman Bennett to adjourn the workshop meeting, unanimously carried.
