## **USDA/Sewer Study Status Update**

Engineer Graham reported that work would begin hopefully in August 2015 once contract details were worked out with Triad Associates. He also stated that contact had been made with the Department of Human Services at the Woodbine Developmental Center (WDC), and he was waiting on comments from their engineering consultants. He hoped that they would come on board once their concerns have been satisfied. There was nothing else to report regarding this matter.

#### **Water Tower Renovations**

Mr. Graham reported that the project was completed and closed out with NJ DCA as far as the grant was concerned. He stated that he had requested MBA Associates to come back, and make a final inspection to make sure no damage had been done to the painted tank when the antennas went back up. A discussion was initiated

regarding the spikes that were initially on the tower and now are not. Further discussion was initiated regarding this matter. Mr. Graham stated that he would follow up.

# **Chlorine Room - Flood Damage**

Mr. Graham gave a status update on the above listed matter. He stated that he was still waiting on a price regarding the needed repairs since AC Schultes had not appeared interested, and had referred him to ABS Electric. He also mentioned that the insurance company had called asking for pricing on said repairs.

## **NEW BUSINESS:**

He stated that the company that had initially installed said filters 40 years ago was still in business. He discussed the cost of replacing certain materials, and DCA's reaction the first time a request was submitted to them for help with funding. A discussion was initiated regarding this matter.
