Mayor Pikolycky called the Workshop Meeting to order and read the following statement, "Adequate notice of this meeting was provided in compliance with the Open Public Meetings Act by notifying the Press and The Herald on January 18, 2019 and posting a copy of said notice on the Clerk's bulletin board."

Those present were: Mayor Pikolycky; Councilpersons Ortiz, Johnson, Bennett, Perez, Benson and Cruz. Also present were Richard Tonetta, Borough Solicitor; Bruce Graham, Borough Engineer; and Lisa Garrison, Borough Clerk.

Mayor Pikolycky called for the Pledge of Allegiance.

Unfinished Business –

Water Quality Management Plan (County) Status - review pending.

County Road Project Phase II 550/638 Status -

Route 550 – bids are now anticipated to be received January or February 2020 with a spring construction..

Roundabout - no change in status

Open Space Eco Park Phases 2 & 3 - Application is pending with announcements anticipated in November. The Bikeway application has been approved. Design work has started. Anticipated bid late December early January. Spring construction. A Creative Placemaking workshop will be held December 2, at the County Freeholder Meeting room. This is County branding program that is to be applied to the Open Space project. There is funding available to upgrade the prior project.

DEP Issues – Asset Management Plan – Status - working on amendments for additional funds. To be submitted next week.

USDA Projects – Status -

Head Start Roof Project – Construction has been started.

Food Bank Phase III - Mr. Graham to work on bid specifications.

Incident Command Vehicle - Application has been submitted.

Fire Truck - Awaiting delivery.

DOT Sumner/Heilprin Avenues Statues – Extra work is completed. Reviewing if remaining funds available to use. Street signage was suggested.

DCA Small Cities Sidewalk Project - plans and specifications to be submitted to DCA next week for review and approval.

Landfill Redevelopment Zone – Solar Project Status - Application pending with the BPU. Anticipate response December or January.

Freidriechstadt Road Vacation Status - Mr. Tonetta reviewed the status of the request.

Master Plan - It is anticipated the Planning Board will be adopting the Master Plan at their next meeting. The next step will be to prepare the zoning ordinances.

Clean Energy Program - Ms. Garrison indicated she is working on the application for the streetlighting.

Airport - Mr. Tonetta reported that work is being completed on updating leases at the airport and also the assignment of G Hangar leases.

New Business –

Local Planning Assistance - Mr. Graham indicated he had attended a seminar for Complete Streets. A resolution is on the agenda for Council's consideration which will authorize submission of a DOT application for preparation of a new Local Bicycle and Pedestrian Planning Assistance Study.
